I am a visual artist, living and working in London. My arts practice references identity through race, gender, personal histories and memories. I explore themes of (dis)location and challenge people's understanding of displacement, belonging and identity.

My own "dislocated" immigrant background creates a focus in my artwork.

It is a strategy to articulate myself at a time when notions of boundaries are being interrogated and transgressed.

I produce artworks to provide a context for dialogue and interaction with the audience and to create new visual narratives.

My photographic series' and mixed media installations incorporating recorded voices, require the viewers active participation.

This transforms the way in which the viewer engages with the work, complicating and challenging the neat categories of artist and audience and the conventionally accepted framework..

I use my artworks to pose questions and provoke alternative views. My work is about revelation and interpretation rather than assumptions and conclusions.
