It is a tough and at times dangerous way to make a living, but for the women truckers who journey across America, trucking is more than a job; it's a way of life. Some have left abusive partners while others are rebuilding their lives after redundancy, but for most, the pull of a life on the road is impossible to resist.

Women make up just seven percent of America's trucking workforce. Although female truckers have been seen as an unwelcome presence by an older generation of men (that believes a woman's place is in the home), attitudes are changing. Undeterred, the female truckers I met during my 10,000-mile journey across the US were resilient and determined to make their mark in this male dominated industry.

Sisters of the Road presents the untold stories of forty female truckers. Each woman's experiences are unique, but together the portraits tell a story of a group of remarkable women who deserve to be heard.
