Julia Hovve is a young artist working between London and Berlin, using photography and film to push boundaries to un-gender, diversify and deconstruct the mainstream visual narrative in society, by documenting people at the forefront of youth fringe and queer culture. Her work explores themes of gender perception and intimacy. She uses her photography to provoke questions about outdated power systems in a society that is rapidly evolving.

Her work has been featured by i-D, HERO, Vogue Italia, ICA and showed work in TATE Modern's Offprint Festival in 2018. As well as photographing, she writes freelance for various magazines and curates group exhibitions around themes of freedom and identity.

Julia is currently on an MA at London College of Fashion.
