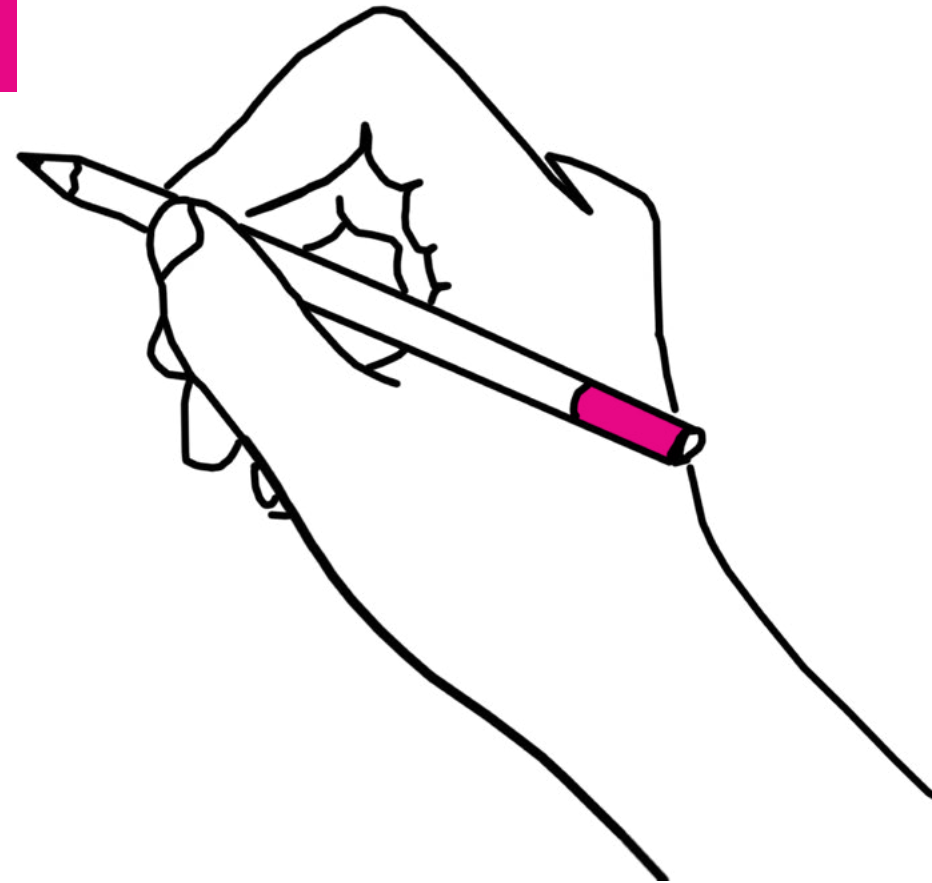


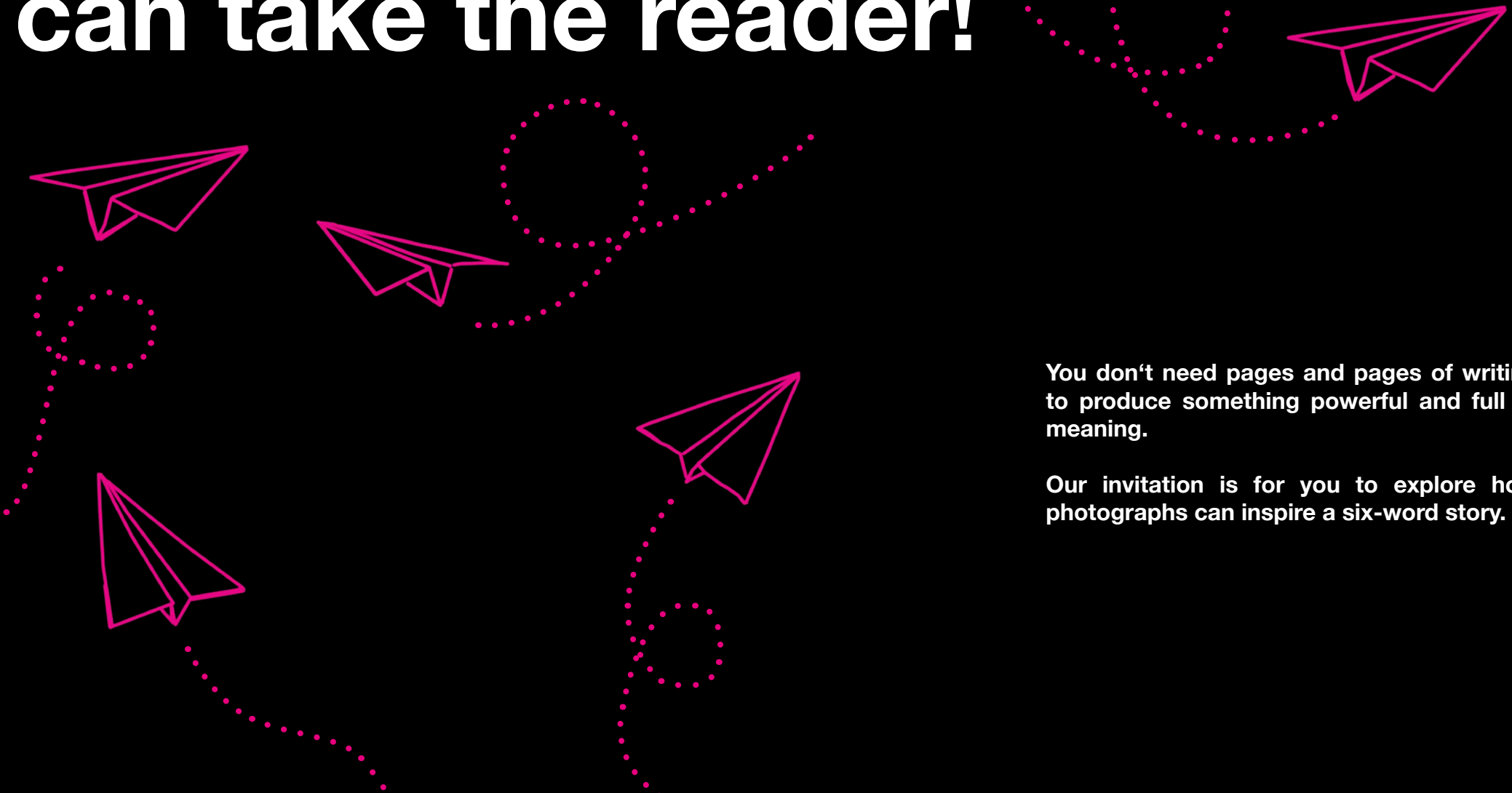
A whole story...

The beauty of six word stories is that they go beyond what you can see in the photograph and build subtext or craft sensory tales. If we explore the “visual language” of an image we can both build and infer meaning.

The *Cabinet of Remedies* online exhibition was created as a response to the COVID outbreak, to help audiences see art from home and also respond to it.

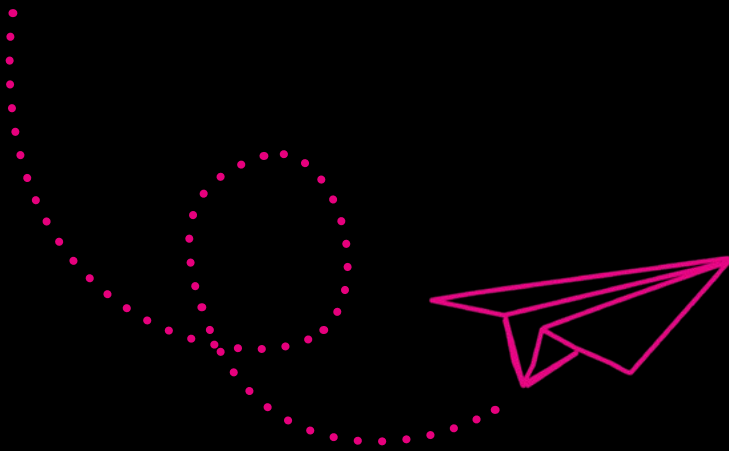
